CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT & COORDINATION¹

The curricula of the schools in the Franklin Central Supervisory Union shall be coordinated to support students to meet or exceed standards established by the Vermont Frameworks and the supervisory union. Curriculum plans shall be coordinated between sending and receiving schools within the supervisory union and will be periodically reviewed to determine compatibility.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for the development, coordination, and evaluation of the curriculum. The Superintendent shall ensure that the curriculum is consistent with the supervisory union mission as approved by the School Board.

Systematic evaluations of all programs within the curriculum will be reported to the School Board at least annually.
